

NASA SENDS WATER-SEARCHING ROBOT TO THE MOON'S SOUTH POLE

The US National Aeronautics and Space Agency (**NASA**) is reportedly going to send robots to the south pole of the Moon in search of water in **2022**. In a statement, NASA said: "NASA is sending a mobile robot to the south pole of the Moon to take a closer look at the area of water glaciers."

In the NASA statement, the robotic vehicle called the "**Vapor Research Pole Reconnaissance Explorer**" (**VIPER**), which is the size of a golf cart to be sent, will excavate on the Moon with its equipment on various soil remains.
